Task 1: English – Create a Crossword! iPad Task

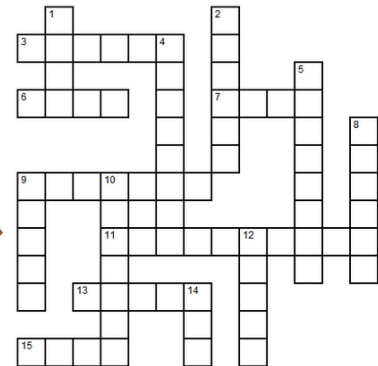
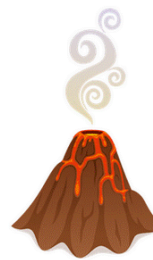
